**Notice concerning the mode of teaching classes for partial studies students studying at
the Faculty of Computer Science and Telecommunications
during the fall semester 2020/21
as a part of the Erasmus students and partial studies students covered by bilateral
agreements**

Due to the current situation associated with the COVID-19 pandemic and assuming several potential alternatives of its future course, the Faculty of Computer Science and Telecommunications of the Cracow University of Technology sets the following class organization for the fall semester of the 2020/21 academic year for Erasmus students and partial studies students covered by bilateral agreements c on Faculty of Computer Science and Telecommunications:

- lectures and all classes (exercises, seminars, projects and computer labs) shall be delivered entirely remotely by default according to the schedule published on the faculty website;
- in special cases, some classes will be conducted on campus (at the Faculty of Computer Science and Telecommunication's teaching facilities, with the physical presence of students and teachers) - however, such mode of conducting classes, requires the Dean's consent and notification two weeks in advance.

The final form of classes shall depend on their type, the size of the student group and the possibility of ensuring safe and sanitary restriction-compliant teaching conditions, as well as the teacher. The Dean reserves the right to order a full shift to remote learning should the epidemiological situation worsen. Specific information concerning the specific format (or formats) for each module shall be defined towards the start of the academic year, taking into account the current epidemiological situation as it develops.

WARNING: Students and teachers shall be cleared for participation in classes upon meeting sanitary regulations applicable during the COVID-19 pandemic: every individual shall be subjected to a mandatory body temperature measurement and shall be required to disinfect their hands and put on a protective face mask.

Requirements for incoming students who wish to study at the Faculty of Computer Science and Telecommunications (depending on current requirements of Cracow University of Technology) can be associated with the following restrictions:

- students who arrive during the 2020/2021 academic year shall be obligated to produce a negative COVID-19 test result obtained no earlier than 72 hours before they arrived in Krakow.

or/and:

- upon arrival and before beginning their studies, all students shall comply with a 14-day quarantine by remaining at their place of accommodation.
