1. Essential qualifications:

- holding at least a doctoral degree in the field of Natural sciences, discipline: mathematics
- declaration that the Cracow University of Technology will be the primary place of employment,

2. Additional requirements:

- teaching or practical experience in: partial differential equations and quantum algorithms,
- excellent teaching skills confirmed by opinions,
- ability to use computer methods in teaching,
- knowledge of R program and Python,
- teaching certificates will be appreciated,
- fluent knowledge of Polish in speech and writing and knowledge of English at a level enabling conducting scientific work and teaching classes,
- professional experience in the economic environment is appreciated

3. Scope of tasks performed/job description (responsibilities and entitlements):

- conducting classes and consultations with students in accordance with the CUT Work Regulations,
- active participation in the unit's research activities,
- participation in scientific and teaching seminars,
- active participation in the unit's organizational work,
- other work assigned by the immediate superior,
- participation in proposed training courses for professional development,
- submitting applications for funding for research projects obtained through competitive procedures.

4. Description of working conditions, we offer, among other things:

○ Remuneration:

- Fixed remuneration components in the amount of:
 - ✓ Base salary ranging from PLN 7 800,00 to PLN 8 300,00
 - ✓ Seniority bonus depending on length of service, i.e., from 3% to 20% of the base salary,
 - Variable remuneration components specified in the Employee Remuneration Regulations.
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- A friendly work environment at a well-established university,
 - Collaboration with a scientific community represented by renowned researchers,
 - Scientific support and opportunities for professional development,
 - Access to research infrastructure,
 - Additional leave days (5–9 days per year depending on the calendar),
 - Additional annual remuneration (so-called 13th salary),
 - Optional group insurance and medical care under preferential conditions,
 - Subsidies for employee and child holidays ("grusza"),
 - Subsidies for sports and recreational activities (pass or membership) and for cultural and educational activities,

- Based on research seminars at another university, the candidate will prepare habilitations in partial differential equations and complex analysis.
- The candidate will support both the Departments of Computer Science and Applied Mathematics with publications on quantum algorithms.

- analysis of the submitted documentation,
- conducting interviews (face-to-face or via instant messaging software),
