1. *Essential requirements:*

- holding at least a doctoral degree in engineering and technical sciences or related fields,
- documented research activity related to the use of advanced computer simulation methods in materials engineering and mechanics, confirmed by publications and participation in conferences,
- documented experience in the implementation or management of research projects financed from external sources obtained in competitive procedures,
- a confirmed scientific record, evidenced by publications and conference participation,
- outstanding, documented international research experience (based on completed scientific internships, participation in research projects, received awards, and other outcomes of research activity),
- documented supervision of doctoral dissertations.
- declaration that the Cracow University of Technology will be the primary place of employment,

2. *Additional requirements:*

- aptitude for working in a research team and with students,



- fluent knowledge of English at a minimum B2 level, or employment at a foreign university in a country where English is the official language. Knowledge of the Polish language enabling scientific work.
3. ***Scope of tasks performed/job description (duties and powers):***
- active participation in the scientific activities of the unit,
 - participation in scientific seminars,
 - active involvement in the organizational activities of the unit,
 - other tasks assigned by the direct supervisor,
 - participation in proposed training aimed at professional development.
4. ***Description of working conditions we offer, among other things***
- a friendly workplace at a university with an established reputation,
 - cooperation with the scientific community represented by recognized scientists,
 - academic support and the opportunity for skill enhancement and professional development,
 - access to research infrastructure,
 - additional days off (5-9 days per year) depending on the calendar,
 - additional annual remuneration (so-called 13th salary),
 - additional and optional group insurance and preferential medical care,
 - subsidized recreation of employees and their children, the so-called "grusza" benefit,
 - subsidies for sports and recreational activities (card, pass) and cultural and educational activities,
 - subsidies for childcare (nursery, kindergarten, or children's club),
 - organising day camps for employees' children,
 - granting low-interest loans for housing purposes,
 - access to the Employee Mutual Aid Fund
5. ***Career development prospects:***
- active application for research grants,
 - support for junior academic staff in their scientific development,

6. Required documentation:

- application to the Rector of Cracow University of Technology for employment as a professor in the research staff group,
- a detailed resume (including past employment history);
- photocopies of documents certifying education.
- list of scientific achievements / self-report,
- personal questionnaire (available on the PK website – "Work at PK" section),
- document confirming foreign language proficiency, additionally for foreign nationals – confirmation of Polish language proficiency,
- declaration of Cracow University of Technology as the primary place of employment.

Employment will take place after a competitive **process in accordance with Chapter VI.**

Phases of the Recruitment Procedure, OTM-R Policy, consisting of:

- analysis of the submitted documentation,
- conducting interviews (face-to-face or via instant messaging software),

Documents not collected by the deadline will be destroyed by a designated committee.
